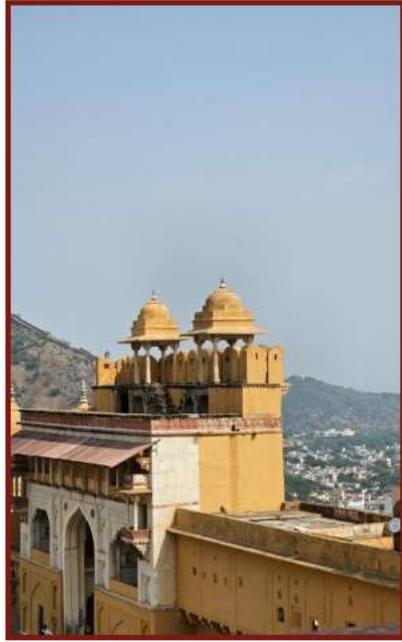

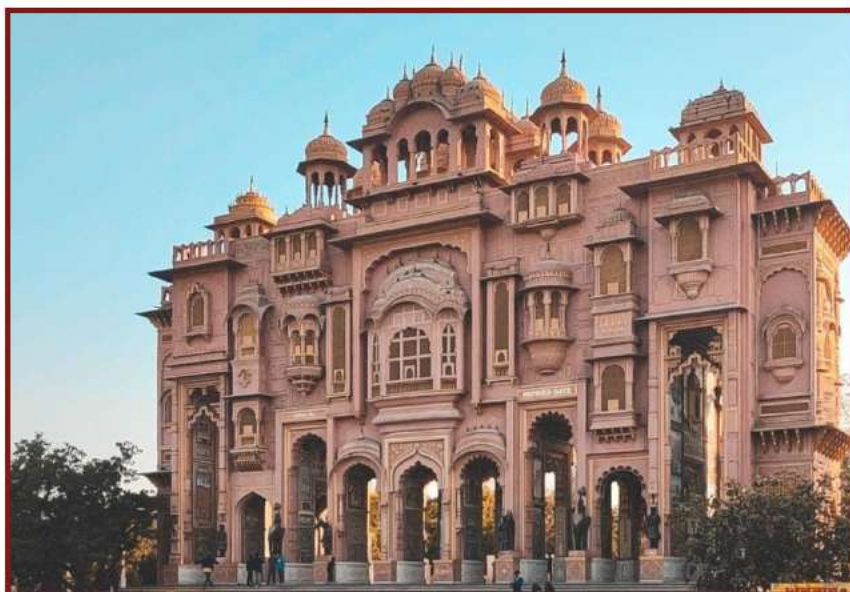

In 1920, the Indian Territorial Act led to the formation of the University Training Corps (UTC), which was later renamed the University Officers Training Corps (UOTC) in 1942.

(b) Recognizing the need for a national youth organization to train young boys and girls as better citizens and future leaders in all walks of life, including the defence forces, the National Cadet Corps (NCC) was established on 16 July 1948 under the NCC Act XXXI of 1948, under the Ministry of Defence.
